


INTERANATIONAL YOGA DAY

SADBHAVANA DIWAS




20th August 2022

Students of 11th and 12th standard have actively participated in the competition.










GANDHI JAYANTI



Group of 16 volunteers conducted the competition in the Seminar Hall at SSIPMT Raipur.




NATIONAL CONSTITUTION DAY


Summary :




One Day Awareness Program on Ill effects of Drugs
